

Letting go.

As we forgive those who sin against us.....

Consider whom in your life you might be holding something against.

Write the names of those you need to forgive on your hand or on a rock, and then wash the names off in the water. As you wash away those names, ask Jesus to help you forgive those people and to let go of any resentment that you may feel.

Walking in truth

Lead us not into temptation and deliver us from evil.

Ask the Lord to protect you from the main temptation that you face (be it money, sex, power or something else) and to keep your eyes on Him.

Take a glow bracelet and as you put it on, ask Him, the light of the world, to lead you on the safe and right path.

Finishing well

For yours is the Kingdom, the Power and the Glory, Amen.

One day we will see the Lord face to face in all of His glory. Ask the Lord to show you one thing in your life that you need to change before that day comes.

Scripture promises that one day God will reward us for the ways that we have faithfully loved, served and obeyed Him. Please take a sweet and as you eat it, know that the Lord sees and appreciates all that you give Him, and one day will be rewarding you!

As we come to the end of this prayer, remembering that from the beginning to the end it is “all about Him”, invite the Lord to fill you again with His Holy Spirit so that you can live for His glory.

The family tree

Our Father who art in Heaven...

Through faith in Jesus we have the amazing privilege of becoming children of God, with a Heavenly Father who is good and who welcomes us into His presence.

Reflect on 1 John 3:1 "How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God" and allow the truth that you have been called first and foremost to be God's child to touch your Heart afresh.

Receive your Father's embrace as you draw near to Him, knowing that His desire is to bless you. If you would like to, take a smiley sticker to wear.

Then think about the members of your families or friends who are yet to discover the love of Jesus. Write your loved one's names on luggage labels and hang it on the tree as you pray for each in turn. Pray that they will come to know Jesus, but also for personal courage to talk about Jesus and invite your family and friends to church activities. Pray God's family will grow and grow.

Worship

Hallowed be your name....

Consider who the Lord is and what he does. Can you use some words to describe and honour Him?

Write the words on sticky labels and place them on the throne. E.g. Almighty, Awesome, Beautiful, Compassionate, Faithful, Forgiving, Good, Gracious, Healer, Holy, Just, Kind, King of Kings, Life, Light, Lord, Love, Merciful, Mighty, Patient, Peace, Powerful, Provider, Redeemer, Restorer, Righteous, Shepherd, Slow to anger, Truth and Unchanging, etc.....

Children might like to decorate the throne with Jewels as they think about Jesus being the heavenly king and ruler over all!

As you look at these news paper's and maps of our area and the world, please pray "your kingdom come, your will be done" over the places and situations that stand out to you.

If you are unsure how to pray then praying for the positive – healing, reconciliation, justice, love, forgiveness, and salvation is often a good place to begin.

Invite the Lord to "reign over" every part of your life, and use you as His witness in all your relationships and wherever you go each day.

Forgive us our sins.....

Reflect on and pray the words of Psalm 139:23-24.

And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting"...*

As areas of sin are revealed to you in your own life, write them down and ask the Lord for forgiveness.

As a symbol of God's grace and forgiveness finish by throwing the paper into the bin.
